The Saga is almost Complete

Over the past few newsletters, Toni has been telling the story of her show biz journey from 1964 when becoming a professional entertainer, to having finally arrived in Australia back in November 1972. Over

the past 50 years her focus changed immensely, first of all being the first entertainer/producer to introduce Ladies Nights into the clubs (that was well before male strippers became the vogue!!) and in the early 80's, the first to introduce Theatre Resturant to clubland at Canterbury Hurlstone Park RSL and Rooty Hill RSL.

Then in 1978, just a few years after the 'Mo' Awards was formed, Toni noticed a void in the industry, where female entertainers rarely got to work together and therefore, most didn't know any of their colleagues. She also noticed that when male performers brought

their wives along to functions, they seemed to get a little neglected with their husbands talking 'shop' most of the evening. And so, she set to work organizing a women's association within the variety industry. Gathering around her several prominent entertainers to discuss options, many names for the association were

tossed around but A.L.V.A. (The Australian Ladies Variety Association) was unanimously decided upon and they welcomed all female entertainers active or retired and the wives of their male counterparts. Toni approached Dame Vera Lynn, who at that stage visited Australia each year, to be their first Patron. She graciously accepted the invitation and remained ALVA's International Patron until her death in 2021. Subsequently, the late Mrs. Margaret Whitlam, the late Lady Sonia MacMahon and currently Lady Joan Hardy, all became national patrons. ALVA became a registered charity and apart from having a lot of fun, they decided that through fundraising they would aim to build a nursing home, similar to Brinsworth House in London which takes care of retired UK performers, but those

thoughts were later abandoned when it became apparent that new rules and legislation in this field were going to make it impossible and, as most Aussie entertainers worked until they drop, there weren't too many who needed it! So now, 44 years on, the association helps anyone in the industry who falls on hard times or who need financial, physical or psychological assistance. Toni is naturally very proud of what she started all those years ago. It has brought companionship and lifelong friendships have been nurtured within it's ranks.

In the meantime, your coach will proceed to Davistown Wharf and pick you up again to transport you to the Club.

Take the train to Woy Woy on your Gold Opal Card, walk about 5-6 minutes to the wharf, then hop on the Ferry service at 10.45 am for just \$10.00 return and enjoy a very pleasant 25-minute trip on the water. The Club bus will then pick you up from the Davistown wharf and transport you to the club returning you to the wharf for your return trip to Woy Woy. Please advise us when booking so that we can inform the ferry service.
